



Morecambe School has been restored, furnished and is being interpreted to represent its appearance in 1929. A few items are still required for this school and for the one-room school also located at the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village. School maps dating from the late 1920s, a map case and school hectograph (duplicator) are a few of the items that we are looking for.

Examples include:

- abacus, hand-held
- map case and maps (late 1920s)
- pencil boxes
- geometry sets
- standing globe on cast metal stand, 1920s
- hanging globe, 1920s (required for the one-room school at the site)
- school hectograph “duplicator”
- glue bottle, pre-1930
