CONTEST GUIDELINES:

- Open to all residents of Alberta, 18 years of age and younger.
- All submissions must be on 11"x17" paper. Any 2D medium is acceptable (crayons, paint, pencils, chalk, collage, etc.)
- Submissions must be post marked or received at the UCHV no later than December 31, 2016.
- Only original artwork is eligible.
- The entry form and completed license must be attached to all submissions (taped or paper clipped securely).
- All entries become the property of the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village. Take a photo or scan your artwork to remember it before you send it in!



NOTE:

Entries that do not meet the specifications will not be judged.

CONTEST CATEGORIES:

- Age at time of submission: 7 and younger, 8-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-18
- Prizes will be awarded to the top submission in each category.
- Top submissions from each category will be exhibited. Additional submissions will be selected to be on display for the summer of 2017.

We shall indemnify and hold harmless the Minister, and his employees and agents, against and from any and all third party claims, demands, actions, or costs (including legal costs on a solicitor-client basis) to the extent arising from a breach of this License, or the negligence, other tortious act or wilful misconduct, of the Artist or Parent of the Artist, or those for whom they are legally responsible, in relation to the Art submitted.

7. We acknowledge that the Minister will use any personal information collected for the purposes of the Where We Came From Art Contest in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (Alberta).

8. We agree that the Artist's full name and age may be disclosed by the Minister when using the Art for any of the purposes described in this License.
